# OVCBCHW TRAIL BOSS REPORT

## January 2016

First of all, I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas and I wish for all of you a very Happy and Prosperous New Year. My wish for the New Year: That your equine friends are faring well, that your hay stack is adequate for another 4 months, and that your woodpile holds at least until mid-March.

2016 promises to be an active and fun filled year for the Okanogan Valley Chapter. Although no work parties or trail rides are scheduled in January, there is a sleigh ride scheduled at the Kvistad ranch in the Chiliwist on January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 1:00 PM with a mid-afternoon chili potluck to follow. More information regarding the potluck is forthcoming from the Social Director. For directions to the Kvistad ranch, contact Stan or Cathy.

In February there are no rides or work parties scheduled.

Our first work party of the year is set for Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup>. We will meet at the Whistler Canyon Trail Head 3 miles south of Oroville to pick up trash, clean up the trail head, spray weeds and plant trees, shrubs and flowers. We will also be draining water off of the first 1/2 mile of the trail up to BLM land. Cathy Kvistad will be the work crew leader.

Later in March, the Chapter will be hosting the State BCHW Packing Championship at Rendezvous on Friday and Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Several judges will be required. Please contact me if you are interested in helping.

On April we will begin the grant work on the trail out of the south Carter Mountain Trail Head on Saturday the 9<sup>th</sup>. The work will involve brushing out the trail corridor, tread and drainage work, construction of a stream crossing and some rock work involving use of the Chapter's new "boulder buster". This project is also a fund raiser for the Chapter; hopefully, we will get a lot of volunteers. April also sees our first ride of the year; Dave Sunde will lead a conditioning ride at the Horse Spring Coulee Wildlife Area on Saturday the 23<sup>rd</sup>. ## John Wayne Pioneer Trail Planning

The Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission has begun a planning process to shape the future of the eastern section of Iron Horse State Park and the John Wayne Pioneer Trail. Iron Horse State Park is a linear park comprised of most of the former 287-mile Milwaukee Road Railroad corridor. Planning for the 110 mile western portion of the Iron Horse State Park trail from Cedar Falls (near North Bend) to Beverly Bridge on the west side of the Columbia River was completed in 2000. In 2014, State Parks completed planning for the 34 mile section of railroad corridor between Malden and the Idaho border. This



## Planning Process

The purpose of the planning process is to engage the public through a series of community meetings. Through the four planning stages described below, the CAMP process will establish land classifications, identify resource management and adjoining property owner issues, and propose approaches for addressing concerns based on careful analysis of resource inventories, technical information, and an issue-based public planning process.

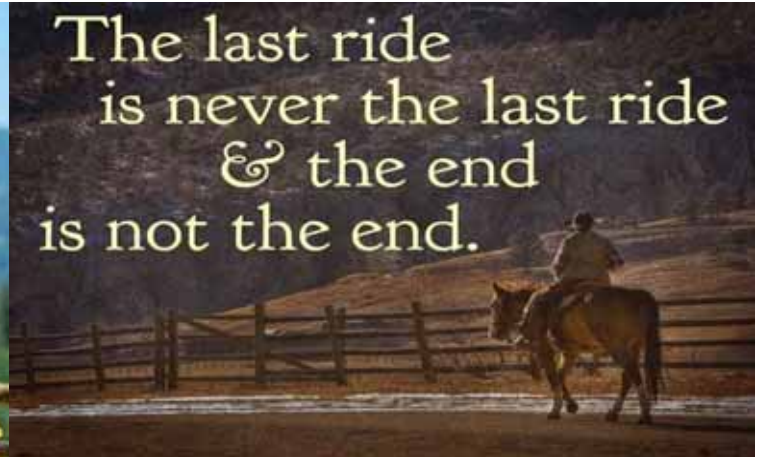
